

Carl Landwehr is Program Leader for National Intelligence Community Information Assurance Research at the Intelligence Advanced Research Projects Activity (IARPA), on assignment from his position as Senior Research Scientist at the University of Maryland's Institute for Systems Research. His IARPA programs aim for dramatic improvements in the overall trustworthiness of National Intelligence Community systems by focusing on accountable information flow, including technologies for privacy protection, and large scale system defense. He also serves as Editor-in-Chief of IEEE Security & Privacy Magazine. For many years he led a research group in Computer Security at the Naval Research Laboratory. Since then he has served as a Senior Fellow at Mitretek Systems (now Noblis), as the first Program Director for the National Science Foundations programs in Trusted Computing and Cyber Trust.
