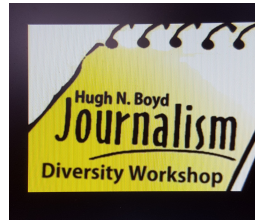


HUGH N. BOYD JOURNALISM DIVERSITY WORKSHOP AT RUTGERS UNIVERSITY

Application Checklist

- * Completed application form (below)
- * Official transcript or copy of latest grades
- * Letter of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher or community leader (should be written by someone unrelated to the applicant)
- * Indicate if you receive or are eligible for free or reduced breakfast or lunch under SBP, NSLP or SNAP
- * Typed 150–200 word essay explaining your interest in the workshop
- * Typed 150–200 word essay explaining how you have personally been impacted by an area of diversity - race, ethnicity, culture, gender, etc.
- * Two writing samples (examples can include news stories, term papers, short stories or blog posts)

About the Workshop

The Hugh N. Boyd Journalism Diversity Workshop (boydjournalismworkshop.wordpress.com) is a nine-day program **for New Jersey High School students** that teaches high school students the basics of multimedia news gathering. Students must be rising Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors.

Admission is competitive. All students selected will receive a full scholarship to the program.

Workshop participants will:

- Live in university housing for a 9-day stay
- Learn about news and feature writing
- Learn to write for the Web
- Prepare photos, slide shows and videos for the Web
- Attend editing sessions with professional journalists
- Work together to publish a workshop Webzine

Students will be selected based on:

- * Writing skills
- * Academic and behavioral performance in school
- * Recommendation letter
- * Student essays (see topics below)

Consideration will also be given to students who receive or are eligible for free or reduced breakfast or lunch under SBP, NSLP or SNAP
