An Independent Study is an individually negotiated learning program of approximately 150 hours, and as such, represents a significant learning opportunity for the student. It provides a framework that allows students to design, negotiate and manage their own program of study based on their existing experience and knowledge as well as their long-term intentions.

NOTE: Independent Study in Information Technology and Informatics (ITI) is arranged by contacting a full-time faculty member in the department. The student must present the proposal to the professor, and once a professor agrees to work with the student, the number of meetings and course requirements are agreed upon by both the participating professor and the student.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Have junior or senior status (minimum of 75 credits)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have completed a minimum of 27 credits in ITI courses  
(not including 04:189:101, 102, or 103)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have at least a 2.75 grade point average in the ITI major
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average
