## Application for INDEPENDENT STUDY IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND INFORMATICS (04:547:460)

An Independent Study is an individually negotiated learning program of approximately 150 hours, and as such, represents a significant learning opportunity for the student. It provides a framework that allows students to design, negotiate and manage their own program of study based on their existing experience and knowledge as well as their long-term intentions.

NOTE: Independent Study in Information Technology and Informatics (ITI) is arranged by contacting a full-time faculty member in the department. The student must present the proposal to the professor, and once a professor agrees to work with the student, the number of meetings and course requirements are agreed upon by both the participating professor and the student.

To qualify for Independent Study in Information Technology and Informatics, you must:

Be an Information Technology and Informatics (ITI) major
Have junior or senior status (minimum of 75 credits)
Have completed a minimum of 27 credits in ITI courses
(not including 04:189:101, 102, or 103)
Have at least a 2.75 grade point average in the ITI major
Have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average
